
TOUR ITINERARY


DAY 1 — ···· ARRIVE MADRID

Today arrive Madrid international airport and are met by our tour representative and transferred to the hotel.

Late afternoon we depart to visit the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium. Later we are transferred to the Indian restaurant for dinner.

DAY 2 — ... MADRID - TOLEDO MADRID

This morning after breakfast we depart for a full day excursion to Madrid &Toledo. Our first visit covers a visit to the Royal Palace followed by Debod temple. Later we are transferred to the restaurant for Lunch. After lunch we precede our drive to Toledo for a panoramic tour and then visit St. Tome church. Later transferred back to Madrid to an Indian restaurant for dinner.

DAY 3 —— MADRID -MERIDA - LISBON

After breakfast we check out of the hotel for a long drive to Lisbon. Upon arrival we check into our hotel and free time. Later in the evening we are transferred to an Indian restaurant for dinner.

DAY 4 — ... LISBON - SINTRA - LISBON

In the morning after breakfast, we visit the Jeronimo Monastery and the Belem Tower. Followed by lunch. Post lunch we visit Sintra National Palace. The Palace of Sintra, also called Town Palace, is located in the town of Sintra, in the Lisbon District of Portugal. It is a present-day historic house museum. Indian dinner and transfer back to the hotel in Lisbon.





DAY 5 — ... LISBON - EVORA - SEVILLE

After breakfast we check out of our hotel and drive for 2 hours to get to Evora and visit the Church of St Francis known as the "Chapel of Bones". Later we drive to Seville and transferred to the restaurant for dinner.

DAY 6 — ··· SEVILLE

Uncover the beauty of Seville, the historic Andalusian capital, on a guided sightseeing tour. View the tiled pavilion of the Plaza de España. Pass the whitewashed homes of Barrio de Santa Cruz See the Gothic Seville Cathedral, the third-largest church in the world Enter the Royal Alcazar, a Palace that was once home to King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella. In the evening we are transferred to see the Flamenco show (1 Drink Included) followed by dinner.





DAY 7 — ... SEVILLE – CORDOBA – MALAGA

Today after breakfast, you begin the drive to Cordoba, once the capital of the Caliphate. On arrival, proceed on a tour of the Mosque of Cordoba, or Mezquita-Catedral (Mosque Cathedral) which is a World Heritage Site known for its stunning architecture. It is the world's third largest mosque, although today it is used as a Roman Catholic church. Later see the Roman Bridge (Puente Romano), which was Cordoba's only bridge for 20 centuries, and stroll through the narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter. Continuing the drive, you arrive at your hotel in the Malaga region and check-in for a two-night stay. The evening is at leisure.



DAY 8 —— MALAGA – GIBRALTAR – MALAGA

From the point of pick-up, we shall initially drive across the runway towards the British/Spanish Frontier. The tour then proceeds towards the southernmost point of Gibraltar, Europa Point and the sight of the only Trinity Lighthouse outside Great Britain. Here you alight from your transport to take some photographs of the panoramic views and busiest shipping lane in the world; the mingling of the Mediterranean Sea and Atlantic Ocean and two Continents. The tour then proceeds to the Upper Rock area and to St. Michael's Cave where one can appreciate a mass of strangely shaped stalagmites and stalactites. The strains of classical music drift through this enormous Gothic style cavern. The Rock Apes spring to mind at the mention of the Rock of Gibraltar and here is where our next stop will take us. King Charles "V" Wall seems to be a usual habitat of the Apes, which are indeed a breed of tailless monkeys (Macaca Sylvanus), which roam free on the rocky slopes. On continuing the tour, we travel via the upper Rock area to exit the Nature Reserve passing by the Moorish Castle and the tower of Homage that still bears the scars of Battle. Finally, we enter the upper Town area. We will drive down the narrow winding roads to exit Main Street"




DAY 9 — ... MALAGA - GRANADA

This morning we depart for Granada. Take a guided tour of the UNESCO-recognized Alhambra, the Moorish sultans' last stronghold in Spain. Walk along the Cypress Promenade to view the upper and lower gardens of Generalife Palace, once the Nasrid dynasty's summer home. Enjoy panoramic views overlooking Granada and the surrounding countryside View the unique curved, Roman-style courtyard inside the Palace of Charles V Admire the blend of Western art and Islamic design as you stroll through ornamented courtyards Enter the Nasrid Palaces and see the Mexuar, where the Council of Ministers met See where the royal family lived during visits to Comares Palace and the Palace of the Lions. Overnight in Granada.

DAY 10 — ... GRANADA - VALENCIA

This morning we depart for a long day of travel covering Valencia on our way to Barcelona. We first visit the city of Valencia the country's third-largest city to enjoy its Mediterranean verve. Vibrant and modern, Valencia still retains much of its past, going back to its Roman foundation 2,000 years ago. Overnight in Valencia.

DAY 11 — ... VALENCIA - BARCELONA

This morning after breakfast we continue our drive to Barcelona where we visit the following: La Sagrada Família, Gaudí's famous masterwork-in-progress. Drive along Passeig de Gràcia, past Gaudí's "House of Bones" Stop at Montjuïc, where the 1992 Olympic Games took place, and stroll through Mirador de l'Alcalde Park Pass Plaça d'Espanya. Rest of the day is free to relax or explore on your own.

DAY 12 — ... BARCELONA - MONTSERRAT - BARCELONA

This morning we on our private bus to visit the famous and scenic mountain of Montserrat. Home for the medieval monastery that is nestled in between natural rock spires high above sea level.
