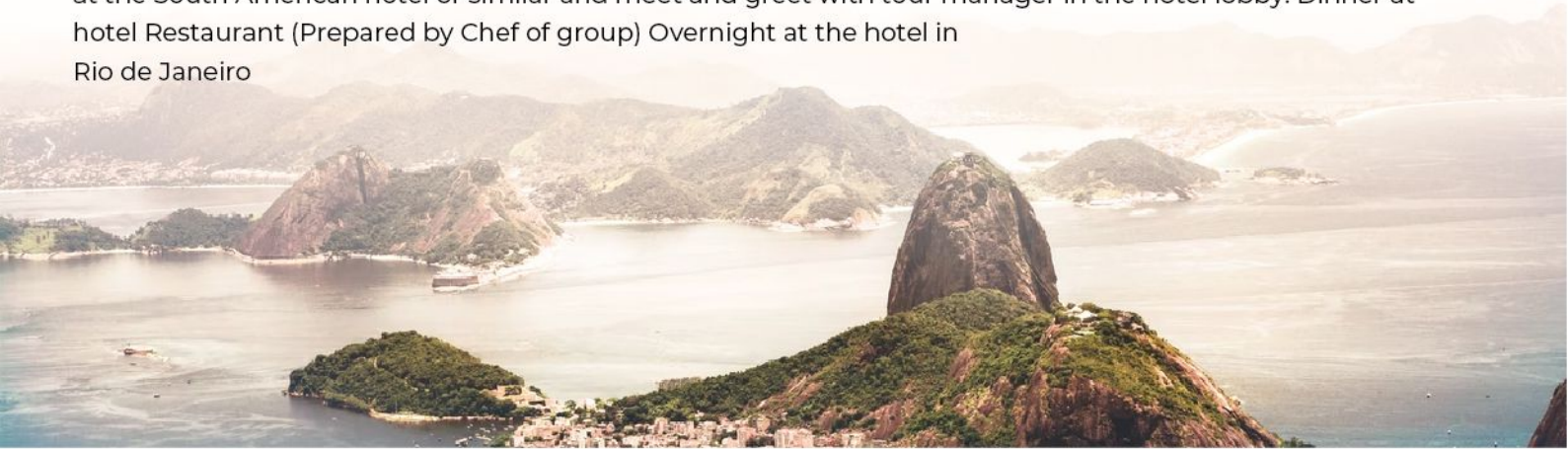

Rio De Janeiro - Iguassu falls - Buenos Aires - Cusco - Lima



DAY 1: ARRIVE AT RIO AIRPORT BRAZIL

Welcome to Rio De Janeiro: Passengers will be picked up from the airport and dropped at the hotel. Check in at the South American hotel or similar and meet and greet with tour manager in the hotel lobby. Dinner at hotel Restaurant (Prepared by Chef of group) Overnight at the hotel in Rio de Janeiro



DAY 2: CORCOVADO & SUGAR LOAF BRAZIL

Breakfast will be prepared by the Indian chef at hotel. Full day Corcovado and Sugar loaf. Visit the Christ Statue, which was recently elected as one of the seven wonders of the world, which sits 2,300 feet above sea level, atop Corcovado Hill. Following a scenic drive along the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, we will arrive at the foot of the hill from where we will embark on a small train which climbs the beautiful mountain. Upon reaching the top, experience the panoramic view of Rio De Janeiro and discover why it is known as the "Marvelous City"! Return to the hotel for lunch prepared by the Indian chef. Next, visit the Sugar Loaf Mountain, an iconic symbol of Rio. Rising from the small peninsula at the entrance of Guanabara Bay, the tour is done in two steps by glass cable cars. The first cable car will take passengers to the top of Urca Hill. From here, the passengers will continue to the second cable car to the top of Sugar Loaf, which offers a 360-degree view of the entire city including Botafogo and Copacabana Beaches, the Corcovado and downtown Rio. Dinner will be done at the hotel restaurant, prepared by the Indian Chef overnight at the South American hotel in Rio



DAY 3: HISTORICAL RIO WITH SANTA TERESA & MARACANÃ (BRAZIL)

Breakfast will be prepared by the Indian chef in the hotel. FULL DAY (8 hours) Historical Rio with Santa Teresa + Maracanã Stadium, walking along the Bohemian neighborhood of San Teresa, you will visit the Ruins Park, a park with an art gallery built around the ruins of a mansion. Up, next, you will walk down the colorful Selarón Steps, one of Rio's landmarks. Next, arrive at the district of Lapa, the zone with the most traditional nightlife Rio has to offer. Take a stroll in the Passeio Publico, the oldest public park in South America, to reach Cinemania, a lively spot in Rio thanks to its bars and cultural attractions. At lunch, we will return to the hotel to have lunch prepared by the Indian Chef. Next, get a behind-the-scenes look at Maracanã Stadium during the guided tour. Explore the stadium, renovated for the 2014 FIFA World Cup. Afterwards, dinner will be prepared by the group chef at the Hotel Restaurant. Stay overnight at the Hotel South American in Rio.



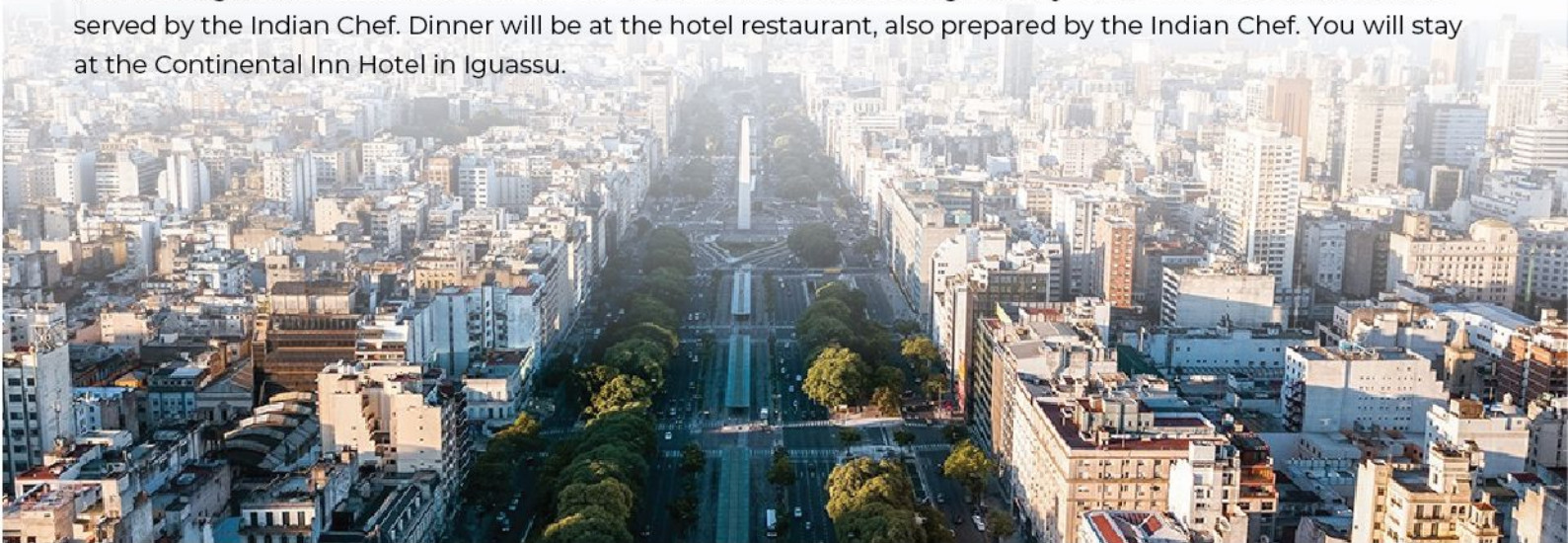
DAY 4: IGUASSU ARGENTINA

Breakfast prepared by the Indian Chef. Transfer out to the airport. Packed lunch will be prepared by the chef. Arrival in Iguassu Falls, meeting at the airport and then transfer to the hotel. At 2:30 there will be a city tour with 3 Frontier Mark, we head for downtown with your local guide and explore the center of the city. Walk down Avenida Brazil and peruse the retail shops and cafes, then visit the city's main Catholic Cathedral, Idrija Madriz. Stop at the Buddhist temple of Foz de Iguacu, where you will hear about its history and learn about Buddhism. Visit the majestic Omar Ibn Al-Khattab Mosque. Next, board your vehicle to travel to the Landmark of the Three Frontiers, where three countries and two rivers converge. After, dinner will be served at the Hotel Restaurant by the Indian Chef. Overnight at Continental Inn Hotel in Iguassu.



DAY 5: BRAZILIAN FALLS (ARGENTINA FULL DAY)

Breakfast prepared by Indian Chef. FULL DAY (8 hours) Brazilian Falls Tour; we will proceed to the Iguaca National Park where we drive through the lush, subtropical vegetation of the park en route to the falls. Stroll the trail descending the canyon that offers a panoramic view of the more than 240 falls. Take the glass elevator up the cliff face for an exquisite view from the upper deck. The Iguassu National Park along with its “sister” park in Argentina from the most significant remaining rainforest in the southern cone of South America, which along with the waterfalls have been declared a National Heritage Site by UNESCO. Packed lunch will be served by the Indian Chef. Dinner will be at the hotel restaurant, also prepared by the Indian Chef. You will stay at the Continental Inn Hotel in Iguassu.



DAY 6: ARGENTINIAN FALLS (ARGENTINA FULL DAY)

Breakfast will be prepared by the Indian Chef. FULL DAY (8 hours) Argentinian Falls; cross the Tancredo Neves Bridge an route to the Iguazu National Park in Argentina. At the entrance the passenger will take a small train for a visit through the park with 2 stops until the trail, where the walking tour begins to visit the Upper Walkways, which will allow for intimate contact with the falls and the rainforest. The highlight of the trip is a visit to the suspended platform at the very brink of the abysmal Devil's Throat- the largest waterfall. This trip shows you the highlights of the Argentinian side. Packed lunch will be prepared by the Indian Chef, dinner will be at the hotel restaurant prepared by the Indian Chef, overnight at the Continental Inn Hotel Iguassa.



DAY 7: BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast prepared by the Indian Chef. Transfer out to the airport. Arrive in Buenos Aires, meeting at the airport and transfer to the hotel accommodation. Dinner at the hotel restaurant, special Menu Indian Food. Overnight at the Hotel Continental Buenos Aires.



DAY 8: TIGRE & DELTA ARGENTINA

Breakfast at the hotel restaurant. Escape the city for a tour of the Tigre River delta and San Isidro from Buenos Aires. Admire the cobble stone streets and grand mansions of San Isidro, then enjoy a cruise around the canals and islands of the idyllic Tigre delta. During the tour will visit the fruit market and the Cathedral and try some handmade Empanadas.

Back to Buenos Aires have lunch at an Indian restaurant. In the afternoon Panoramic city tour. Will take through the highlights of south Americas most European and cosmopolitan city. We'll drive along 9 de Julio Avenue where the renowned Colon theater and the Obelisk, symbols of our city are located We'll visit Plaza de Mayo, surrounded by important historic buildings like the Casa Rosada, the cathedral, and the city hall. The tour will drive us along the old fashion Avenida De Mayo and the dynamic Avenida Corrientes. Explore Neighborhoods Filled with Colors and history like La Boca and San Telmo and the sumptuous neighborhoods if Palermo. Other highlights are commercial and financial areas plus La Bombonera. Boca's Football Stadium. Dinner at hotel restaurant. Special Indian Menu. Tango show with dinner. We will watch the authentic roots and the pure essence of the Argentina tango in full show of music, singing and dancing of the top artistic quality. Overnight at the hotel continental Buenos Aires.



DAY 9: ARRIVE CUSCO PERU

Breakfast at hotel restaurant. Transfer out to airport Buenos Aires Arrive at Cusco Peru. Upon arrival in Cusco, transfer to your hotel. There explore the town. This day, attend an orientation meeting with your tour manager. Check in at Sonesta Hotel Cusco.



DAY 10: FULL DAY AT MACHU PICCHU

Early morning, transfer to the train station to board the **Vistadome Train** that travels from misty peaks to the astonishing ancient citadel of Machu Picchu, the lost city of the Incas, designated by **UNESCO** as one of the seven wonders of the world. Spend the morning viewing the unforgettable wonders of this 15th century retreat abandoned nearly 100 years later with the arrival of conquistadors. Highlights of this site include the **Temple of Sun, The House of the Priest, the Sacred Plaza**, and intricately carved rock likely used as a sundial for the ancient Incas. Return in the evening and transfer to the Sonesta Hotel Cusco for overnight stay. Dinner prepared by Indian Chef.



DAY 11: CUSCO CITY TOUR

Breakfast at the Hotel. Spend today discovering the Imperial City of Cusco, once the capital of the Inca Empire and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This lively city, rich in history, reveals remains of both the Inca and the Spanish presence. Join the highlights of the Cusco excursion that takes you to the impressive Colonial Cathedral with its collection of over 400 paintings, the Temple of the Sun and the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, which took over seven decades to complete. Dinner at the hotel restaurant prepared by the chef of the group, overnight at the hotel Sonesta Cusco.



DAY 12: LIMA

Today we will transfer you from the Hotel Cusco to the airport for your departure flight to Lima. Arrival into Lima city, we will meet you and transfer to the Hotel in Lima located in the Miraflores district. Check into the Hotel Jose Antonio. Dinner at the hotel restaurant prepared by the group chef and overnight stay at the Hotel Jose Antonio.



DAY 13: LIMA

Check out. Breakfast prepared by group chef, tour of the City Lima, capital of Peru which encompasses thousands of years of history. Known as the “City of Kings”, it was once the political, administrative, and religious heart of South America. Transfer to the hotel and then to the Lima airport,

- We charge late fee of \$15 USD per person for bookings that come in within 10 days of travel and \$25 wire fee applies for all transactions.

- The weather can vary considerable depending on the month of travel. Please make sure to have weather appropriate clothing. Walking shoes are recommended. Always carry jackets and closed comfortable shoes as it can get colder at the Glaciers and mountains
- Tour Manager has the right to change the itinerary based on Weather and traffic conditions. Please follow protocol while on tour.
- Always make sure to have all the necessary documents with you.
- Tours Limited does not hold any responsibility for any injuries or accidents that might happen while on tour. Passengers are requested to carry Insurance with them to safeguard themselves in case of any eventuality. Our Tour managers will do all they can to aid the passengers in their time of need.
- Children under 2 years travel free. Child price is applicable for children between the ages of 3 years to 9 years. 10 years and Older are adults.

- Standard room is with King bed. For 2 or more passengers (maximum occupancy is 4 per room), we will book a room with two double beds. For parents traveling with children, we will book a room with 2 beds. Rollaway beds are not allowed in a room with 2 beds.
- Early Check-in can only be requested, they are not guaranteed.
- Our Pricing for the hotels includes room rate, taxes and Breakfast if applicable. The passengers are liable to pay for any additional incidentals that they may incur at the hotel.
- Is This Trip Right for You?
- This moderately active trip covers a fair amount of ground each day. Expect from three to four hours walking every touring day. The pace is moderate; however you will encounter some uneven surfaces, stairs, steps and significant slopes. When
- visiting Machu Picchu, please be aware that walking sticks are allowed but require a prescription and need to have a rubber tip. Also, selfie sticks are forbidden, and only folding umbrellas are allowed. The elevation of 11,000 feet in Cuzco,
- may be a consideration for those who have heart conditions or are otherwise affected by altitude. We suggest you check with your healthcare provider before signing up for this tour.

COVID GUIDELINES:

- All passengers are required to wear face coverings or masks while on Tour and in Public spaces and also observe social distancing at all times.
- Passengers body temperature may be checked by our Tour Managers during a Tour at regular interval.
- Hotels, Restaurants, Attractions have their own COVID-19 guidelines, and passengers are expected to adhere to their rules and guidelines.
