DAY 01: CAIRO (D)

- Arrival at Cairo International Airport, greeted by our representative who will assist the group through immigration and customs formalities.
- Transfer by our deluxe coach to your hotel in Cairo for check-in @ 15h00
- @ 19h00 Evening tour (Sound and Light show). The Sound Light show pyramids will take you on a journey thousands of years back, bringing the Egyptian legacy back to life! Thousands of years have passed since the pharaohs walked on earth, leaving behind a mystery on how the great pyramids were built. And we can't just skip the enigmatic sphinx, standing prominently as a guard to protect the Great Pyramids.

 With the Sound Light Show at the Giza pyramids, the pharaonic history is being re-told by the sphinx, unraveling the ancient secrets and mysterious tales. The Sound and Light show at the pyramids narrates the history of those great kings, Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure.

- Overnight.





DAY 02: CAIRO/ ASWAN-NILECRUISE (B/L/D)

- Early morning after breakfast, transfer to Cairo Domestic Airport to take your flight to Aswan.
- Arrival to Aswan Airport, greeted by Tours Limited representative.
- Visit the Philae Temple This beautiful temple complex is one of the most picturesque in all of Egypt. It sits on Aglika Island just south of the old Aswan Dam and you must ride a water taxi to the island to get to the ruins. The temple was moved to its current location following the construction of the High Dam, which threatened to submerge it permanently. The careful reconstruction at the current site carefully completed, painstakingly preserving the original appearance and layout of the complex and even landscaping the island to match its former location. Philae rose to prominence during the Ptolemaic Dynasty as the center of the cult of the goddess Isis. This complex was actually one of the last remaining places where the ancient religion survived after the arrival of Christianity in Egypt, officially closing only in 550 AD. Early Christians then used the main temple on the island as a church. This is the reason for the defacement of some of the figures of the ancient gods as these Christians often tried to remove the pagan imagery from their newly claimed sanctuaries. The Temple of Isis is the main feature here, but there are several other smaller temples on the island that are worth spending time admiring.

Continue with High Dam the Aswan Dam, or more specifically since the 1960s, the Aswan High Dam, is an embankment dam built across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt, between 1960 and 1970. Its significance largely eclipsed the previous Aswan Low Dam initially completed in 1902 downstream. Based on the success of the Low Dam, then at its maximum utilization, construction of the High Dam became a key objective of the government following the Egyptian Revolution of 1952; with its ability to better control flooding, provide increased water storage for irrigation and generate hydroelectricity the dam was seen as pivotal to Egypt's planned industrialization. Like the earlier implementation, the High Dam has had a significant effect on the economy and culture of Egypt.

After visits transfer to your Nile cruise for check-in.

Overnight in Aswan.





DAY 03: NILE CRUISE (B/L/D)

- Early morning with breakfast box, at fixed convoy time at 04:00 am, transfer by A/C vehicle to Abu Simbel.
- Enjoy your Abu Simbel Day Trip from Aswan. Our Representative will pick you up from your cruise in Aswan by a PRIVATE air-conditioned vehicle to enjoy Abu Simbel which its main attraction is the great sun temple of Ramses II and the temple of queen Nefertari. Both temples were discovered in 1813 it was almost completely covered with sand. Then both temples were moved in 1960 by the help of Egyptian government and UNESCO to avoid the rising water of the Nile. Ramses II built the temple mostly to honor himself as inside there is a mural depicting his famous victory at Kadesh battle where his army defeated his enemies. On the north of Ramses temple, the Nefertari Temple which was built by Ramses II to his favorite wife Queen Nefertari among other 200 wives and concubines. After finishing the visit, you will be escorted back to your cruise in Aswan by your private air-conditioned vehicle

At around 13:00 Sail to Kom Ombo, visit Kom Ombo Temple. The Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. It was constructed during the Ptolemaic dynasty, 180–47 BC. Some additions to it were later made during the Roman period

· Sail to Edfu and overnight.

DAY 04: NILE CRUISE (B/L/D)

- Visit Edfu Temple. The Temple of Edfu is an Egyptian temple located on the west bank of the Nile in Edfu,
 Upper Egypt. The city was known in the Hellenistic period as Koinē Greek: πόλλωνος πόλις and Latin
 Apollonopolis Magna, after the chief god Horus, who was identified as Apollo under the interpretatio graeca.
- · Sail to Luxor.





DAY 05: NILE CRUISE / LUXOR/CAIRO (B/L/D)

- · Checkout after breakfast.
- Visit Valley of Kings Our first tour will be Valley of the Kings, the magnificence of the grandeur of architecture which was used for burial, there are many kings buried in this valley of the kings, listen well to your Egyptology tour guide who will tell you the great stories of the tombs.
- Continue with Queen Hatchepsut Temple Enjoy the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by Queen Hatshepsut, daughter of Thutmosis I, who ruled Egypt about 20 years during the 18th Dynasty (approximately from 1490 to 1469 B.C), the only pharaonic woman who reigned ancient Egypt
- Transfer to have Lunch at Local restaurant
- Visit Karnak Temple Karnak is a complex of temples built in different reigns, and during about 2000 years of
 renaissance almost every king ruled Egypt added a part to Karnak temple, starting with the Avenue of
 Sphinxes, the Hypostyle, the Obelisks, shrines, pylons and many other additions. Karnak beats every other
 pharaonic monument, it is simply one of the most beautiful ancient monuments in Egypt
- After Karnak you will be taken to Luxor Temple, which is dedicated to the Theben Triad of Amun-Ra, Mut and
 Khonsu. There you will see the granite statues of Ramses the Great. These ancient temples are a must-see for
 Luxor travelers. As it is the sight of one of the most important festivals of ancient Thebes the "opet" At every site
 you will get information from your Egyptologist tour guide
- After visits transfer to Luxor Airport to take your flight to Cairo. (Must be evening flight)
- Arrival to Cairo Domestic Airport, greeted by Tours Limited tour leader who will transfer clients to their hotel.
- Transfer to have Dinner at local restaurant
- · Overnight at Hotel in Cairo.





DAY 06: CAIRO (B/L/D)

- After breakfast At 08:00 am Pickup from your hotel to Start your full day tour visiting Giza Pyramids where you
 Visit the Great Pyramids Cheops, Chephren & Mykerinos then Visit the Valley Temple where the Priests
 Mummified the dead body of King Chephren Also there you will have a close-up look at The Sphinx The
 legendary guardian that stands by the huge funeral complex with its lion body and the head of king
 Chephren. Then Lunch at Local restaurant
- Continue your day tour to the Egyptian Museum of antiquities. It displays the largest and most precious items
 of the Egyptian art in the world. It exhibits a rare collection of over 250,000 genuine artifacts that date as far
 back as 5000 years, including an exclusive exhibit dedicated to the Tutankhamon A collection of treasures,
 gold, and jewelry that were buried in his tomb for over 3,500 years before they were discovered in the 1920s
 when his tomb was excavated.
 - Then Visit the Khan El Khalili Bazaar. The numerous shops in this district are known for trading fine brassware, copper, perfumes, leather, silver, gold, antiques and much more.
- Transfer to have Dinner at local restaurant
- Overnight in Cairo

DAY 07: CAIRO/FINAL DEPARTURE (B)

• Checkout after breakfast, transfer to Cairo International Airport for final departure.
