(Day 01)

Hanoi Arrival (D)

Your Vietnam adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

(Day 02)

Hanoi - Halong Bay (B/L/D)



In the morning, check out of the hotel, and get picked up by the Cruise team. Take the most scenic route to reach Halong Bay, taking you across the Red River Delta with emerald green rice paddies stretching for as far as the eyes can see.

On arrival at the pier, you will board the cruise and enjoy the fantastic views of limestone rocks and the karst grottoes. Have an utterly delicious seafood lunch and enjoy the time at the sundeck exploring the Bay.

The cruise will stop in a secret place where you will spend time kayaking or swimming, so you can explore the karst grottoes closer. Towards the evening, you will return to the boat for an early dinner, followed by some time at leisure. You can optionally attend the activities taking part on the boat or just relax.

(Day 03)

Halong Bay - Hanoi (B/L/D)

Rise early today to view the sunrise at the wonder of nature with breakfast served in the dining room. A Tai Chi class on the sun deck will awake your mind and muscles. Then head off to visit the limestone cave full of stalagmites and stalactites. After your exploration return to the boat to check out and enjoy the brunch while the cruise is sailing back to the harbor. Later you will be transferred to your accommodation in Hanoi.

(Day 04)

Hanoi Fly To Danang Visit (B/L/D) - Flight Included

Relish the remaining moment in Hanoi before your private driver and tour guide escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Da Nang. When you arrive at Da Nang Airport, your driver and tour guide will pick you up and transfer you to Hoi An.

visit Marble Mountain which is one of the most beautiful landscapes in Da Nang. It resembles five fingers rising out of the ground and named after the basic elements of the universe: water, wood, metal, fire and earth. The tour consists of exploring the mysterious Tang Chon, Huyen Khong and Am Phu caves with pagodas and temples inside, hiking up the very scenic viewpoint where the Emperors of Nguyen dynasty often prioritized for visiting.

Stroll around the Non Nuoc village that located at the base of the mountain specialize in marble sculpture, admire amazing products of the creativity and skillful hands. Take your time to collect your favor souvenirs.

Visit Thuan Phuoc Bridge – the Vietnam's longest suspension bridge, head north to Son Tra peninsula where truly satisfies your expectations of the beautiful views. Stop for great pictures of Man Thai fishing village which is well-known for fresh sea food and making fish sauce. Overnight in Danang.



(Day 05)

Danang - Day Trip To Golden Bridge & Bana Hills (B/L/D)

8:00 AM: Start from your hotel to have a full day visit to Ba Na hill complex. Located at 1478m high above the sea level and 25 km to the west of Da Nang, Ba Na Hill has a yearround cool climate which makes it an ideal resort since French colonist time. On arrival, take 20 minutes of the world's impressive cable car in order to reach the peak of Ba Na hill and observe the beautiful scenery.

Arrive at the station, take a visit to pagoda with giant Buddha statue, green gardens of multiple kinds of flora and flower interleaved by French architecture buildings and wine storages. Leisurely walk on the World's top ten impressive architecture bridges – Golden Bridge. Immerse into the stunning views of national park, waterfall, ocean and city in remote distance which can hardly found in other regions.

Enjoy the entertainments in Fantasy Park – the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with series of interesting games before getting transfer back to city.

Keep your way toward to Linh Ung pagoda with the highest statue of the Goddess of Mercy in Vietnam (67 meters high). Leisurely walk in marble sculpture and bonsai garden, enjoy the stunning views of ocean and city with its white sandy beaches.

On the beautiful days, it is worth to drive on steep slopes path with a cliff side of ocean to Ban Co peak. Immersing into beautiful nature, pure air, particular vision and meditate your mind in peace before driving back to city.

Come back to your hotel in the late afternoon.



(Day 06)

Danang - Hoi An Visit (B/L/D)



After breakfast, transfer to Hoi An.

When arrival visit Cam Pho - one of the oldest communal houses in Hoi An. It was built in the shape of Chinese character means the country for worshipping and trading business and cultural exchange between locality and Chinese, Japanese traders.

Have a short waking to the Hoi An city's symbol - the Chua Cau or the Japanese Covered Bridge, built in the 17th century to allow the Japanese quarter to be accessible from the Chinese neighborhoods. The bridge's original style has been carefully preserved for the last 400 years.

Continue to Quan Thang ancient house - one of the most authentic old houses in Hoi An with the lively and fine architecture and sculptures were made by craftsmen of famous Kim Bong carpentry village in the oriental style. The house offers a good look of Hoi An family's daily life.

Follow itinerary to Phuc Kien or Fujian Assembly Hall, built since 17th century, is the gathering place for residents, traders and visitors from a specific area in China called Fujian. It is also a religious site to honor the deity Thien Hau. Spend a visit, you will admire the colorful fountains in the courtyard, the ornate gates surrounding the property and the beautiful carved dragons in the main room.

(Day 07)

Hoi An - Cam Thanh Coconut Village Hoi An Tour - Danang - Fly To Ho Chi Minh City (B/L/D) - Flight Included



8:00 AM or 1:00 PM: Our private car and tour guide will pick you up at your Hue hotel in the morning before we begin our journey from Hoi An to Cam Thanh coconut village. Here, to discover its beauties, you can take a basket boat (Thung Chai) trip through the coconut forest and discover more about the community and daily life of Vietnamese fisherman. The people of Hoi An Coconut Village make a living by weaving fishing nets, making basket boats, making coconut objects, building houses out of palm leaves, and harvesting edible bird nests. The coconut forest has been home to many aquatic species for generations such as: fish, shrimp, crab and even animals' soft body. In addition to defending the Cham Islands World Biosphere Reserve from the sea's waves, it has shielded the Cam Thanh inhabitants.

Additionally, locals will show you how to paddle the distinctive bamboo basket boat used only in Vietnam. You will hear tales of earlier conflicts and the trying circumstances that soldiers faced. It was a bloody battleground. Quang Nam's Cam Thanh people were renowned as the "land of steel" during the war, fighting the enemy to secure the nation's independence.

During the trip, the boatman will collect coconut leaves and use them to fashion amusing natural ornaments such as hats, rings, and glasses. It's fantastic for you. You will undoubtedly experience the sensation of floating on the waves of water and will participate in an equally enjoyable basket boat race between the baskets in the cheering and bustling music drum.

Participate in river fishing with locals and get experience with cast or round nets. Passengers are permitted to attempt the catching on their own, under the guidance of locals. Undoubtedly, having fun on the water before landing is very common. Learn more about life and people while also learning how to take attractive photos.

Transfer back to Danang to take the flight to Ho Chi Minh. When you arrive at Ho Chi Minh airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

(Day 08)

Mekong Delta (B/L/D)

Kick start your day with a hearty breakfast, and a trip to Mekong Delta follows. The guide will meet you at the hotel lobby around 7:15-7:30 am, and you will head to My Tho, which lies on the left side of the Mekong River. Upon arrival, see brick making in handy traditional style by printing and baking. Visit one of plenty of coconut processing workshops located along canal. Turn on natural scissors creeks where they look smaller and smaller to go to village. Take a walk to family workshop making sleepmats and enjoying some fruits and tea. Riding a motor cart (xe lô) or bike on shady paths, pass by green rice fields and vegetable plains to be able to touch on realy life and find out about tropical culture from Peasants. Lunch at Hai Hô house. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.



(Day 09)

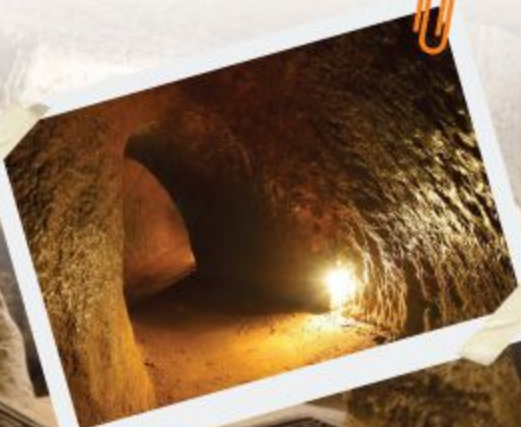
Cu Chi Tunnels - Ho Chi Minh City Tour (B/L/D)

Have breakfast at the hotel and depart for Cu Chi tunnels. The trip will take approximately one and a half hours drive. Upon arrival, you will have a short introduction followed by an introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed, and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of wartime.

Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems, which included the living areas, kitchens, and bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers. All this was to help people living inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purposes during the war. Afterwards, special tea and cassava (guerilla food during the war) will be served.

Take the afternoon trip to visit Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace. The Independence palace is a widely known landmark of Ho Chi Minh City and was designed by the architect Ngo Viet Thu. Continue seeing the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times, such as the Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Central Post Office. Continue to the War Remnants Museum, which has a vast display of both the Indochina wars.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.



(Day 10)

Ho Chi Minh Fly To Siem Reap (B/D) - Flight Included

Have breakfast at the hotel and gave some rest before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Siem Reap. When you arrive at Siem Reap Airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

(Day 11)

Siem Reap (B/L/D)



Start your sightseeing tour of Angkor area we spend a full day exploring the wondrous ancient ruins with the South Gate of Angkor Thom, which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and the largest as well as the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards, and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple and the jungle-covered temple of Ta Prohm is an incredible sight. There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature.

Overnight in Siem Reap.



(Day 12)

Siem Reap (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit to Floating Village, take a ride by traditional wooden boat on Tonle Sap Lake to experience the human occupations at the edges of the lake is similarly distinctive – floating villages, towering stilted houses, huge fish traps, and an economy and way of life deeply intertwined with the lake, the fish, the wildlife and the cycles of rising and falling waters. In the wet season, the Tonle Sap Lake is one of the largest freshwater lakes in Asia. Afternoon, We will drive to the Pouk district about 15 Km in the West of Siem Reap town you visit the silk farm, a fascinating farm/workshop where you can see the entire silk creation process including growing the food for the silk worms, breeding the worms, silk extraction and refinement, traditional kit dying pattern creation and looming. Retail silk and souvenir shop. On the way back, visit the Western Baray (Baray Occidental) measuring 8 km by 2.3 km which provided water for the intensive cultivation of lands around Angkor.

(Day 13)

Siem Reap Fly To Bangkok (B/L/D) - Flight Included

Have breakfast at the hotel and rest before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Bangkok. When you arrive at Bangkok airport, our staff will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. Lunch at Indian restaurant.

Pick up at hotel. A ride through the interesting parts of Bangkok with stop at the Golden Buddha, Reclining Buddha.

This tour takes you through the hustle and bustle of Bangkok to visit two of the capital's most significantly and visually stunning temples. Wat Traimit houses the world's largest solid gold Buddha (5.5 tons of precious metal) and Wat Pho, which is the oldest temple in Bangkok and houses of the Reclining Buddha, a 45 meter-long statue which depicts Buddha entering Nirvana. Wat Pho is also Thailand's first university and houses a wealth of art. It is still an important centre for traditional medicine and massage.

FTDx Damnaern Saduak And River Kwai Tour With Lunch (No Train) (B/L/D)

Early pick up from your Hotel, we will take you out of Bangkok for an Adventure and Discovery of native Thai people along the way to Ratchaburi to visit Damnaern Saduak Floating Market about 100km away from Bangkok. At Floating Market we will take the boat along the canal to see how Thai people live alongside the labyrinth of canals in this area. You can stroll around the colorful floating market place bustling with boats and vendors selling tropical fruits and other delights. Chance to test some local fruit and Kodak Moment with guarantee you would love the area and fill up before depart. Later we continue to Kanchanaburi to see the famous bridge on the river Kwai, built by Allied prisoners of war, this will bring you back to the incredible of World War II. Short trip by long-tail boat to visit JEATH Museum. Dinner at Indian restaurant
