Arrival Vancouver

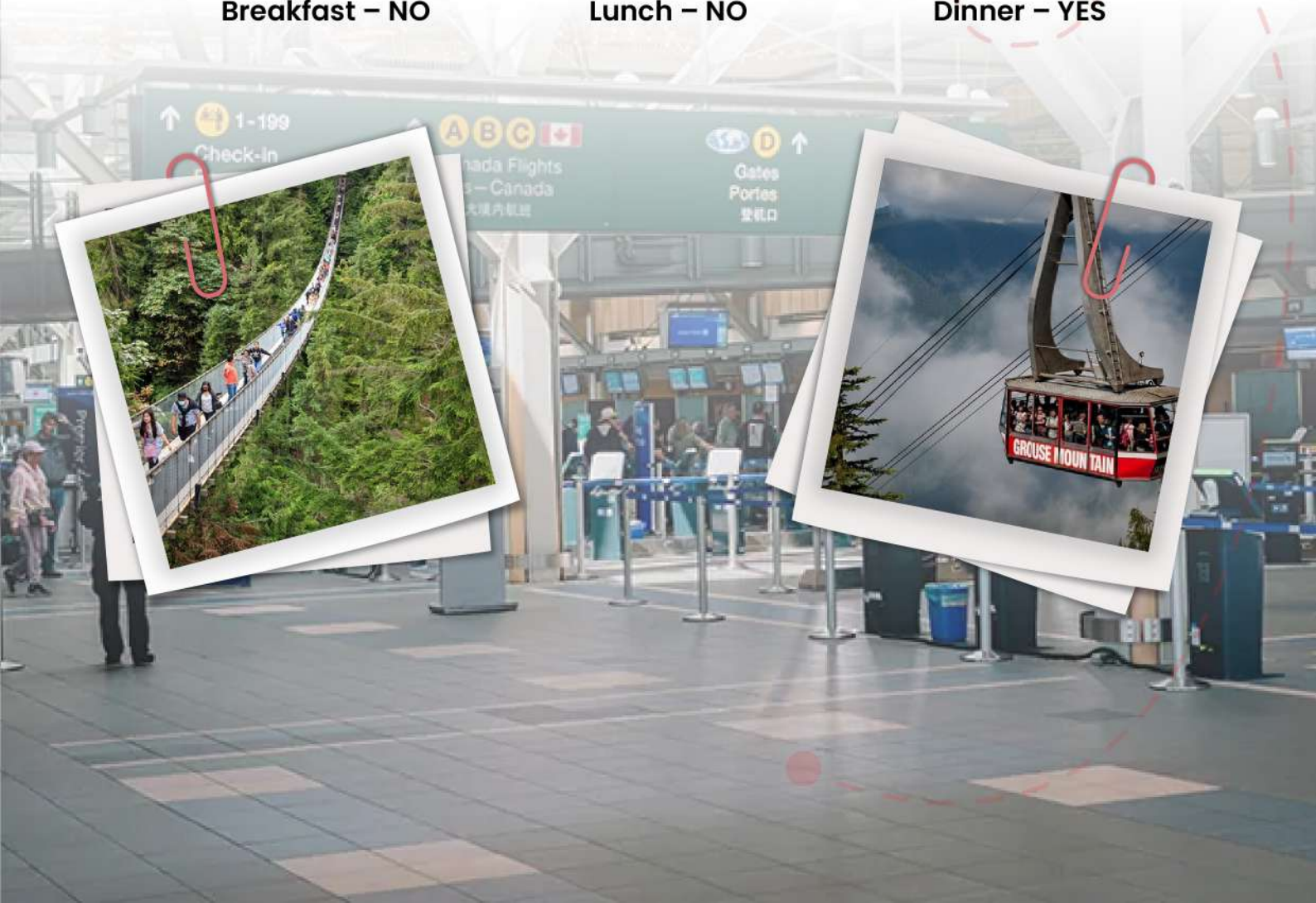

Vancouver – Daytrip to Whistler

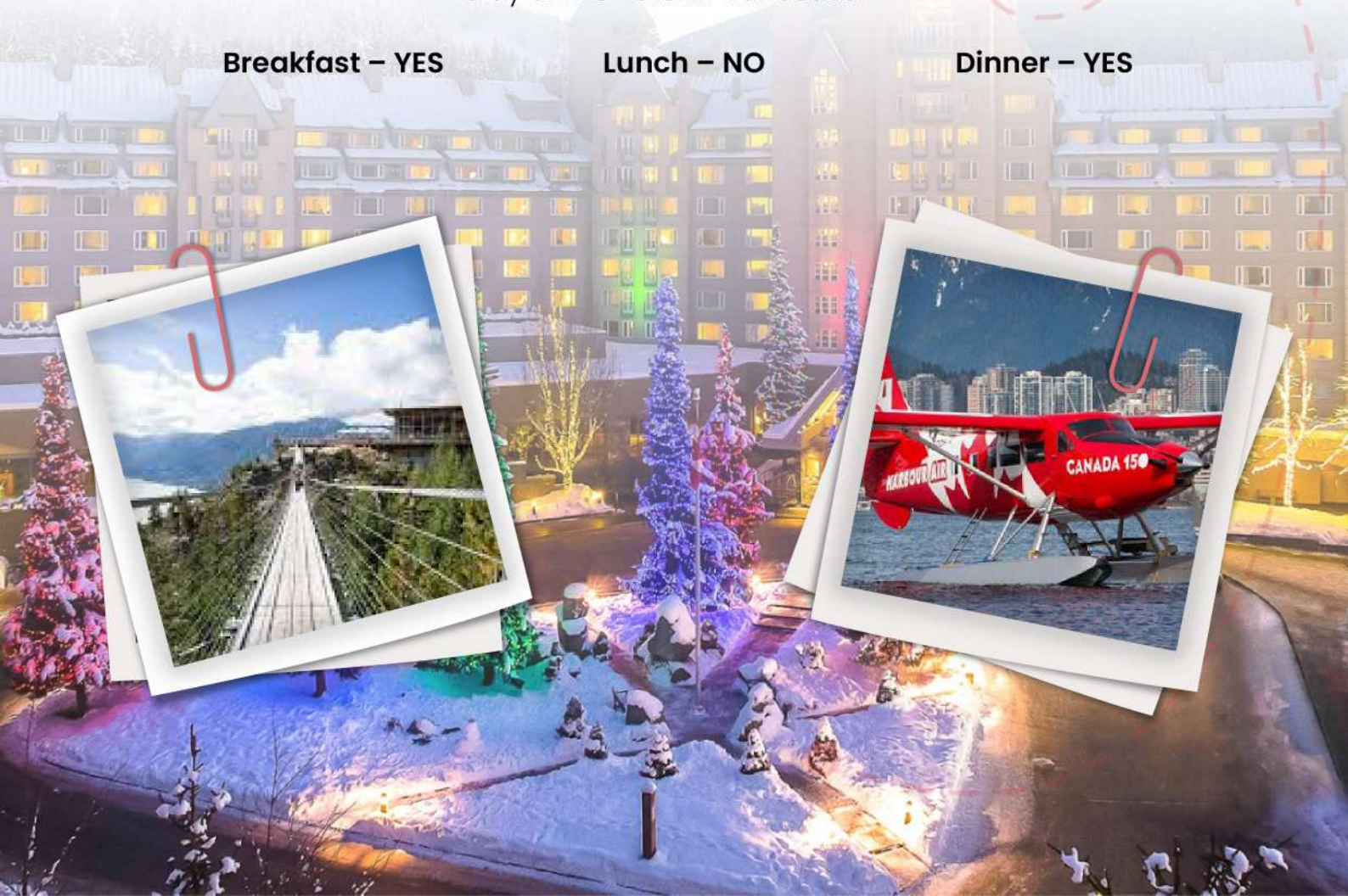
